### **.NET Solutions Bridging Program for Internationally Trained IT Professionals**

A tuition-free 24 week program that will provide you with in-depth knowledge of application development using Microsoft .NET 3.5 and database administration, implementation and maintenance using SQL Server 2008.

Graduates will have the skills required to write the Microsoft Certified Technology Specialist (MCTS) and/or Microsoft Certified Professional Developer (MCPD) exams. This program is offered in partnership with JVS Toronto.

### **Engineering Software Skills Enhancement Program**

A tuition-free part time, 22 week program that will provide internationally trained engineers with training in the latest technical and software skills in demand by Ontario employers.
