Did you know?

- 1 OTSS stands for Ontario Trust for Student Support, a government program that matches contributions for endowed scholarships, dollar for dollar.
- 2 An endowed scholarship is a fund that is invested forever and only the interest earned is put towards a scholarship.
- 3 The average cost for a full year of study is \$7,000.
- 4 Over \$73,000 was raised in 2008/2009 from Humber’s Board of Governors, employees and retirees.
- 5 Due to lack of funds, only 3 per cent of applications were awarded scholarships in 2009.
- 6 If you give as little as \$5 per pay for a year, this translates into \$260 with government matching.
