

## SERVING/SELLING OF ALCOHOL ON HUMBER PREMISES

The sale and service of any alcoholic beverages in any campus facility is subject to the regulations of the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO).

Humber is licensed to serve alcoholic beverages **only** in the designated areas shown below and **only** under the supervision of Food Services, HRT or CAPS.

As Humber is under one license for each campus, a single violation will result in the loss of the Humber licence for **all** designated locations within the respective campus severely impacting on the delivery of academic programs and other non-academic events.
