## ONLINE LEARNING AT HUMBER

### What is online learning?

A course taken fully online without physically meeting a teacher in a classroom on campus. These courses may be semester-based, with specific start and end dates or may have a timeline based on the date of your enrolment.

### Is online learning for me?

Although online learning is a convenient way to take courses, it's not suited to all students' learning styles or needs. Online learning students should be self-disciplined and have excellent reading, writing and analytical skills.

### Computer requirements for online courses.

You will need regular access to a computer with a reliable Internet connection to actively participate in an online course. We recommend the system requirements listed on the following chart for all online courses. Lesser systems may not be compatible with the systems used to deliver online courses.

Some courses have specific software requirements; therefore, it is important to visit the Open Learning Centre's website prior to the course start date and visit the specific course page for complete details. If you are required to download additional software, see chart on the following page.

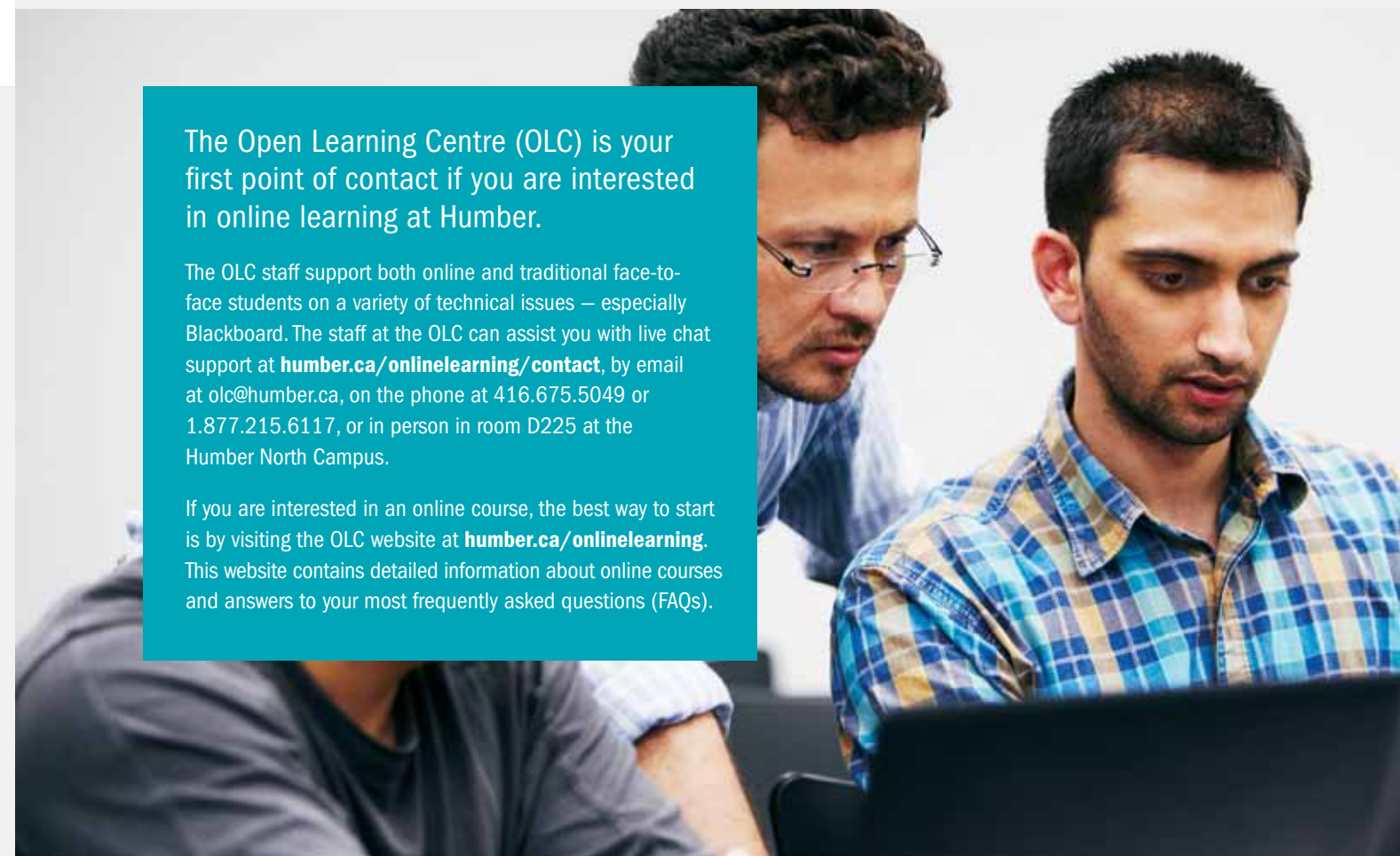

# WE ARE HERE TO HELP

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### Who is eligible to register for a continuing education course?

For most courses, a student needs to be 19 or older or have a Grade 12 diploma. For many general interest courses, however, that qualification doesn't apply.

### How do I register? How do I pay?

You can register online at [humber.ca/continuingeducation](http://humber.ca/continuingeducation). To register online, you will need a Humber username. If you are a new student, or can't find your username, please call Customer Service and Registration Centre at 416.675.5005 or 1.877.675.5660 to obtain one.

You can register over the telephone too. Payment over the phone is by Visa or MasterCard only. You can also visit us in person at the Humber North or Humber Lakeshore Campus. There, you can pay by Visa, MasterCard, debit card, certified cheque or money order.

### What's a prerequisite? What's a corequisite?

A prerequisite is required for entry to a specific course. For example, you may need to have completed an entry-level course before taking an intermediate one. A corequisite needs to be taken at the same time as another course.

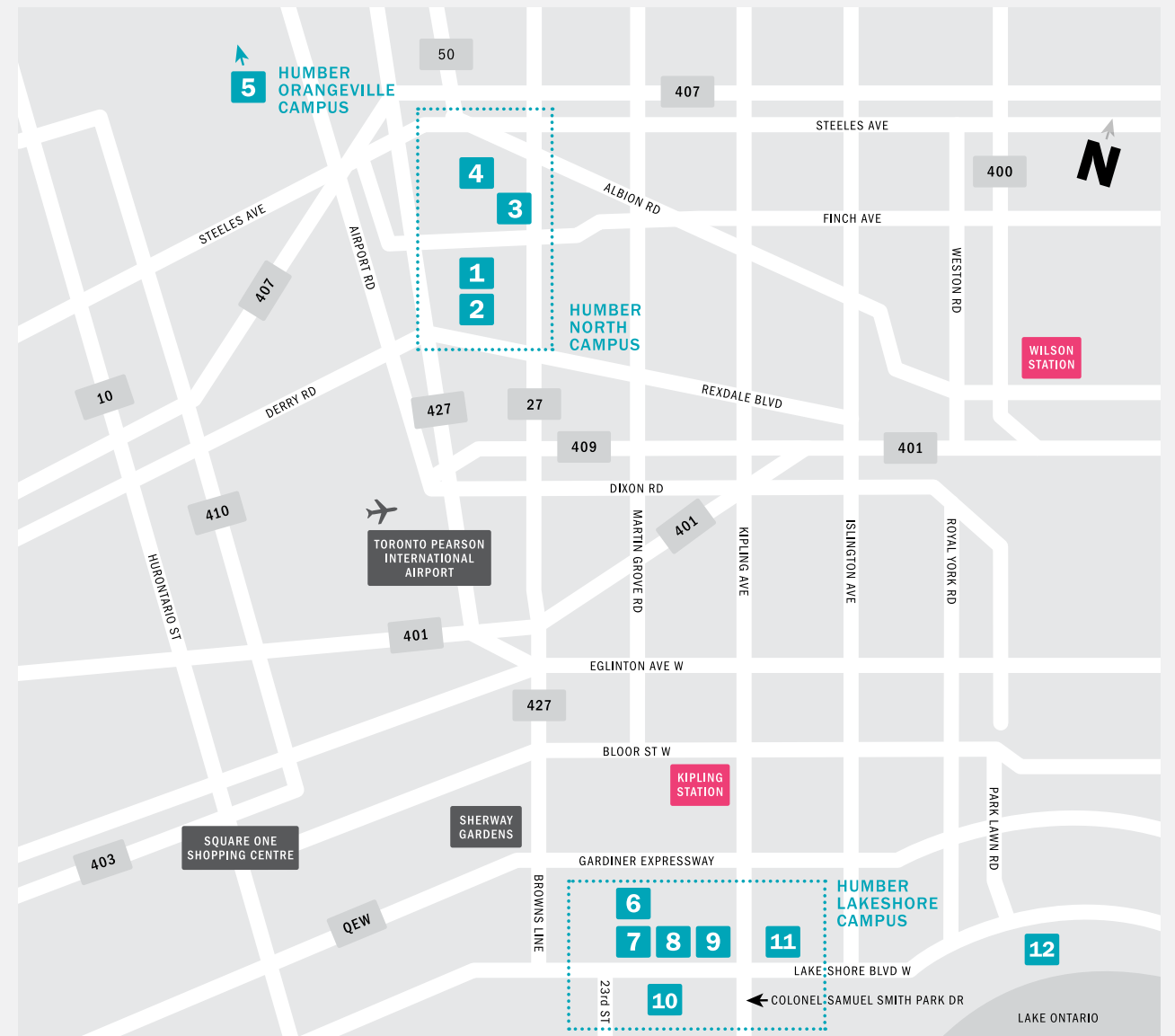
### I have credits from another institution or previous work experience. Can I apply those to my program at Humber?

Students who have successfully completed postsecondary studies may apply for transfer credits from equivalent courses in their program. You will need to provide a transcript and a detailed course description. Transfer credit forms are available at [humber.ca/transferecredits](http://humber.ca/transferecredits).

If you've had previous work, volunteer or life experience that is relevant to your program, this can also count as credit towards your course or program. You can submit an academic portfolio, or complete challenge processes like tests, demonstrations or interviews. There is a fee charged for each course challenged. For more information on Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR), please go to [humber.ca/plar](http://humber.ca/plar).
