On May 16th, 2014 a group of Humber College students will embark on a unique, one of kind learning experience to Germany, Poland, Lithuania, Estonia, Finland, Sweden and Russia. Study @ Sea is an experiential multi-country learning opportunity in partnership with the Institute for Shipboard Education & Enrichment Voyages.

Students learn about the history, politics, environment and culture of the countries being visited through enrichment lectures and interactive workshops delivered by academic faculty. At each destination, students participate in field excursions of their choice that include adventure, culture and community outreach programs.

SOS Children's Village Russia is an independent non-governmental organization that provides a family approach to the long term care of orphaned and abandoned children. We bring orphaned children back to the natural atmosphere of the family giving them back a mother (an SOS-mother), a home and a happy childhood in a supportive Village environment. We help children shape their own futures and get ready for independent life. Since 2006 we are extending our work with families through family strengthening programs by working for disadvantaged families to prevent crises that can in the worst case scenario lead to children being placed in out-of-home care. It is estimated that 1.8 million children are abandoned in Russia.
