As an eduroam participant, Humber students and employees can now wirelessly connect to the Internet at other participant institutions at no cost.

And conversely, students and employees at other participant institutions can now wirelessly connect to Humber's network for Internet access.

eduroam is available in 65 countries. Currently, there are 99 participant institutions in Canada handling 7 million logins a month.
